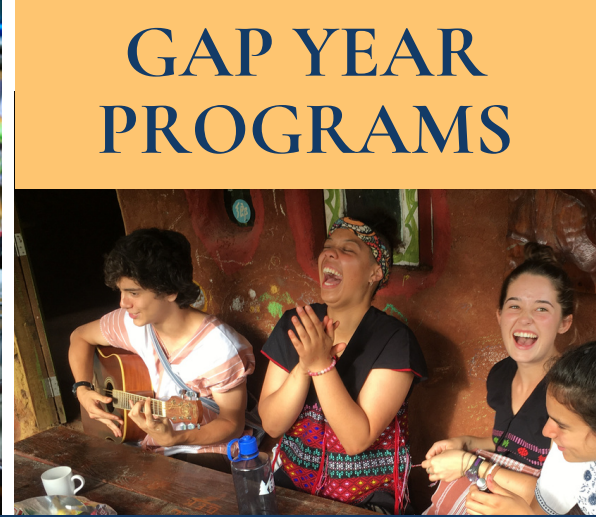


GAP YEAR PROGRAMS
